I. FAMILY: By His grace, all our children, grand children and great grand children are in good health. One of our grand daughter(Helen's aughter Krystal had been to Africa, for a period of 6 months as she was deputed by air force department on a special project. Merlyn's daughter Carol completed her MBBS course in Kirkisthan and is back in India. Helen is regularly visitng India to do village medical ministry for two months a year.

II.EVANGELSIM:

- a) **NEW SOULS:**Through the sincere efforts of our pastors, Bible women and club leaders 192 new souls added to AIM family to make total 2643. Women prayer cells formed 221.
- b) **CHILDREN SUMMER SCHOOL:** The total number of children attended for Children Summer School in 2019 are 8,67,708.

II.EDUCATION:

- a) **PRESTON JUNIOR COLLEGE:** The Preston Junior college is having 93 students including first and second year for college education. It is being run by 12 teaching staff(2 full time and 10 part time) and 2 non-teaching staff.
- b) **AGAPE GOOD SHEPHERD HIGH SCHOOL:** There are 284 children. The school is being run by 18 teaching staff and 2 non-teaching staff. 8 of our children participated in dictrict(county) level science fare competition, we got second prize. 2 of our children participated in state level wrestling competition under 14, we got second prize. Our children participated in games and cultural programmes, which was conducted by Integrated Children Development Services, we got many prizes.

III. HOME FOR THE AGED: 10 residents currently boarding in the home for the aged, 1 care taker and 1 cook are helping. A compound wall is fixed around the area of aged home to safe guard the trees and safety of the aged home members.

IV. MARY LOUIS SLATER MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, THARIGOPPULA: We are happy to run the hospital with the following staff.

1. NEWLY ADMITTED ORPHAN CHILDREN CASE HISTORIES.



I am Bandari Lathif studying in 9th standard I belong to Hindu background. I am from poor family. My father and mother both died because of family disputes between them. I used to have one elder brother he also passed away. No one is there to support for my further studies. One day I went to CBC in summer, there I came to know about Jesus Christ. One of the AIM Pastors came to know about me and suggested me to join in hostel to continue my studies. He brought me to Dayanilayam. I thank to Sir Dr. K.M. John & Mother Jayamani madam who gave me an opportunity to continue my studies here. Every day

evening in our prayer service I am knowing more about Jesus and many other stories from bible. I am keeping my surrounding clean and learnt to move friendly with my friend.

I am Cheriya Koushik studying 8th standard and I am from Hyderabad. I belong to Hindu background. I am from poor family. My father died because of yellow fever. My mother working in different house for her daily wages. Financially she is not able to take care about our studies. I have one sister. One of my uncle name Bhasker told us to join in Dayanilayam. By his suggestion my mother brought me to join in Dayanilayam. My heart full thanks to Dr. KM John sir and Jayamani madam for accepting me in there hostel to continue my education without any problem. The reason I joined here in Dayanilayam is to learn good discipline and good behavior. Every day in our prayer service I'm learning many new things and life changing stories from the bible and I came to know more about Jesus and his wonders and teachings.



We Angothu Sandeep studying 9th Class and Angothu Sanjeev studying 4th class. We belong to Hindu community from Suryapet district. Our father died because of regular consumption of alcohol. Our mother is a farmer and taking care of our family. She alone couldn't able to take



care about our studies because of financial problems She joined us in Dayanilayam hostel through one of the AIM pastors. Our Heart full thanks to K.M. John sir and Jayamani madam for receiving us and giving us admission in this hostel. In our daily evening praye time we are learning many good things. Our teachers teaching us good moral stories.

I am MoodaSagar, studying in 4th standard I belong to Hindu background. my father is a factory labor and he met with train accident and died. I have 2 brothers and my mother is working in a private school as a teacher. My mother alone laking care of us. It became hard for my mother to maintain the house by single income. Due to financial problems my mother joined me in Dayanilayam through one of the AIM pastor. Dr. KM John sir and Jayamani madam allowed me to join in there hostel and to continue my studies here. In our daily evening prayer for children our shanti sir teaching good things and telling stories from the bible and about Jesus Christ. Now I'm learning discipline and also learning how to adjust with things what we have. And learnt how to move friendly with friends. I am keeping my surroundings clean.



.We Nunavath Sai Kumar, studying in 8th standard and Nunavath Pavankumar studying in 5th standard. We are from chinthalthanda Tharigoppula. Our family belongs to Hindu community. Our father used to work as a lorry driver and he died because of disputes between his elder brother for their land property and suddenly his elder brother murdered him. From that day onwards our mother alone taking care about our family. She is a daily labor worker and looking at our needs. It became hard for her to take care of our studies. One of our relatives told our mother about Dayanilayam. This year our mother brought both of us to join in Dayanilayam hostel. Dr. KM John sir and Jayamani madam came to know about us and Our Situation they accepted to join here. Now we are happily continuing our studies.



2. PROPOSED ORPHANAGE PROJECT IN PEDDAPAHAD.

We are thankful to God that the land at Peddapahad was a gift, for the new project to be built in Peddapahad village, to accommodate children with more facilities as per the instructions given by the children home rules of Govt.

The land is being leveled to make proper building plans, as per the instructions given by the engineers.

7. MEDICAL CAMP AT MLSMH :

In the month of August an eye camp was done in Mary Louise Slater Memorial Hospital with the help rendered by Pushpagiri Eye Institute, Hyderabad.

About more than 300 adults men & women were eye checked. But 60 eye cataract patients were sent to Hyderabad for surgery two times.

Later medical checkup was done for school & hostel children. Most of the Children were found less weight and anemia.

So, Medical advice was given for each child who needs medical & dietary Plan.

The doctors of Unicorpus have visited MLSMH to assist the programme for better functioning.



8. Kalpana--- Dayanilayam Child.

As you know that Kalpana is an Orphan child of Dayanilayam for the last 18 years.

She was found in the outside Hindu Temple crying about 18 years ago at the age of 7 years.

She was raised here ever since. She completed her nursing course and got married to a pastor named David who ministers to a village congregation along with his mother.

Now She gave birth to a beautiful girl baby on 3rd September 2019. Later her post-operative condition was very serious, but as she was treated well in a very good hospital(Max-care hospital, Hanamkonda). She and her baby are doing well and are still with us. She needs to continue her medication for 3 to 6 months, as she is anemic and needed balanced diet for sometime, being a nursing mother.



9. PAINTING TO KENT'S ACADEMY:

The School building is painted, but 2nd floor needed help to be fix the stones on the flooring.



10. OUT DOOR PLAY ITEMS FOR PRIMARY CHILDREN:

The need of outdoor play items was also our prayer to make PrimarySchool going children to make happy, in Agape good shepherd School.

As such,ourPrayer was answered by Sharline James and her Children of Cincinnati in their recent visit to India in the month of July 2019. Children are Happy.
